

RIW Attorney Christopher Agostino Presents at National Institute for Coastal & Harbor Infrastructure Boston Harbor Storm Surge Working Group

On July 31, 2019, Ruberto, Israel & Weiner **Attorney Christopher Agostino** joined a panel of engineers, economists, and planners to present the case for a regional “Layered Defense” approach to protect Boston and surrounding communities from the effects of sea level rise and storm surge. RIW is a member of the **National Institute for Coastal & Harbor Infrastructure (NICH)** and has both hosted and participated in NICH’s Boston Storm Surge Working Group to discuss the benefits of an outer-harbor flood barrier in addition to other coastal infrastructure.

NICH’s meeting focused on the cost savings that would be realized if an Army Corps rated seawall eliminated mandatory flood insurance for properties within flood zones mapped by FEMA. An Army Corps rated barrier constructed in the Boston Harbor could dramatically reduce the extent of flood-prone areas in and around Boston, thereby relieving property owners of the need to purchase expensive flood insurance.
