TITLES

WETLANDS & ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE

We advise clients on wetlands issues under both local bylaws and the **Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act**, including representation before Conservation Commissions and the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

REPRESENTATIVE MATTERS

- Secured a favorable judgment in the Massachusetts Land Court for Benevolent Botanicals, finding that the City of Malden's zoning ordinance violated MGL ch. 94 (g), making it "unreasonably impractical" to obtain approvals and operate a marijuana establishment. [Access the Decision here.](#)
- Secured a precedent-setting Land Court decision, upheld by Appeals Court, confirming that cannabis cultivation constitutes an "agricultural use" under local zoning bylaws, rejecting a planning board's attempt to classify cultivation as light manufacturing. [Access the Decision here.](#)
- Served as lead counsel for Grandis Homes LLC in securing a comprehensive permit under Chapter 40B for a 170-acre residential development in Medway, Massachusetts, enabling construction of 136 single-family homes.
- Served as counsel to TowerCo, alongside co-applicant Verizon, in obtaining local approvals for construction of monopole telecommunications facilities in Acton, MA and Sanbornton, NH.
- Served as counsel to Viridi Wireless, alongside co-applicant AT&T, in obtaining local approvals for construction of a monopole telecommunications facility in Greenfield, Massachusetts.
- Secured approval of the first "Planned Development District" in City of Medford and related permits for construction of mixed-use commercial/residential development with 65-units.
- Secured a favorable judgment in Land Court, upheld by Appeals Court, ruling that a dominant estate can realign, change grade, and widen an access drive if reasonably

necessary for its use and enjoyment, so long as such improvements do not unreasonably increase the burden of the servient estate holder. [Access the Decision here.](#)
